Dear Ms. Dodd:

We have completed our review of the Region 2000 Services Authority's 2011 Recycling Rate Report submitted pursuant to <u>The Virginia Regulations for Solid Waste Management Planning (9VAC-20-130-165)</u>. State law (10.1-1411) and section 120.B. of the regulations require each city, county, town or region to maintain a minimum recycling rate and to report the data for the previous calendar year to DEQ by April 30 of each year. The members of the Solid Waste Planning Unit were to meet or exceed a 25% mandated recycling rate based upon the criteria established in 2006.

We accept your data as submitted with one data entry edited, and the region's calculated recycling rate for CY 2011 will be reported as 38.8 %. This information has been forwarded to DEQ's Office of Waste Permitting and Compliance for consideration during their reviews of the Solid Waste Management Plans.
